3. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

Care Farm 06/20/0444/CU – meeting opened to allow the applicant and a parishioner to speak

After discussions and hearing member of the public concerns - PCllr Lamb proposed the PC has no objections, however there were concerns over potentially additional traffic down the private road, seconded PCllr Searle, two voted for and 1 against (Chairman didn't vote, which was in line with Standing Orders)– vote carried.
